- 1. I have personal cognizance of the matters set forth herein, and hereby verify that the same are true and correct to the best of my information and belief.
- 2. I am a write-in ballot observer in Juneau. I have reviewed hundreds of ballots since the start of my observations.
- 3. On November 10, 2010, I was reviewing write-in ballots at the table. The Division of Election employees, Florence Tong and Isaac Kearns, opened and began to review ballots from District 1, Precinct 150.
- 4. I was shocked to discover that when the ballots were taken out of their packet, they were already sorted in two stacks by senate candidates (Miller and McAdams) and write in ballots. In other words, prior to the Division of Elections official sorting,
- someone had previously accessed the ballots and sorted them in apparent violation of the law and in apparent violation of the chain of custody of those ballots.
